The 57th running of the Oxford Invitational, later renamed the "Elmer Ball Invite" after the longtime Wildcats mentor, has become one of the most competitive track & field invitationals in the state of Michigan.

While many things have changed – Oxford Blue turf, a new track and even a new stadium—much has remained the same. The same principles of teamwork, school pride, hard work and commitment established by Coach Ball have been continued by the current staff of coaches and volunteers today.

Honoring Coach Elmer Ball

A mentor to thousands of students in and outside the classroom, Elmer Ball is regarded as not only the most successful track & field coach in Oxford history, but one of the most successful coaches in the history of Oxford athletics.

Ball began teaching in Oxford in 1954 after graduating from Central Michigan University with a bachelor's degree in Drafting and a minor in History. During his 36-year career, he taught not only drafting, but wood working and mathematics. Prior to his time as a Chippewa, Coach Ball attended Reed City High School where he earned five letter awards in the sports of football, basketball and track and field.

As the Wildcats' head cross country coach from 1963-74 and again from 1995-96, Ball's teams established a 123-21 dual meet record, claiming four MHSAA regional championships and four league titles. The boys' team finished as the 1971 state runner-up behind individual state champion Doug O'Berry. Previously, Ball coached Jim Goodfellow to a cross country state title in 1969.

If his cross country accolades weren't enough, Ball's name is synonymous with Oxford High School Track and Field. He was an assistant under legendary coach Lee Noftz from 1964-80 and was promoted to head coach in 1981. He led the Wildcats to a 101-18 record in dual meets, eight league championships, an Oakland County co-championship and the MHSAA Class 'B' Boys' Track Title in 1991. When Ball stepped down after the 1992 season, he had coached 11 individual state champions in as many years on the job.

A leader not only in the teaching ranks, Ball was also a leader in his avocation as well, serving as president of the Michigan Interscholastic Track Coaches Association (MITCA) in 1975 and earning numerous awards from the organization. Elmer was named Oakland County Coach of the Year in 1988 and 1991 and earned MITCA Coach of the Year honors in 1983 and 1991 as well. Ball was honored with MITCA's Charles Sweeney Award in 1988 for outstanding service to the sport of track and field, his school, community, and MITCA. Sweeney Award recipients epitomize the definition of "Coach."

Ball was inducted into the Oxford High School Athletics Hall of Fame in 2010.

Sadly, we lost Coach Ball as he went to be with his wife, Jeraldine, on February 28, 2017. Although Coach has left us, the profoundly positive mark that he placed on the track program, his athletes, the student body as a whole, and the rest of the Oxford Community will live on.

• Full concession stand located at North end of the stadium

- No locker rooms available, trainer will be available for entire meet.
- Please keep athletes out of school unless severe weather strikes.
- Please warn athletes not to jump fences, they will be warned once then disqualified for the remainder of the meet.
- WARM-UP area will be from the goal line to the 20 yard line of the north end zone.
- NO FOOTBALLS or FRISBEES in the fenced area.

Coaches, the press box and timing tent is for our workers. Please address any questions or concerns with the meet officials.

FIELD EVENT GUIDELINES: Athletes are not to check out to running events until second call.

Throws: Boys Discus and Girls Shot Put first.

3 throws per entry: 2-1 format.

Top nine to finals: 3 throws, 1-1-1 format

Minimum Distance measured: -Discus: 100'- Boys, 75'-Girls -Shot: 28'-Girls, 40'-Boys

1st legal try will be measured regardless of distance, those meeting minimums thereafter

Long Jump: Boys will jump first-90 minute open pit, Finals to follow (top nine-open order), followed by the girls.

Minimum Distance measured: Girls 14', Boys 18'


1st legal try will be measured regardless of distance, those meeting minimums thereafter

High Jump: 5 Alive Format

Girls First: Starting Height: 4'2", 3" first two raises, 2" thereafter Boys Follow: Starting Height 5'4", 3" first two raises, 2" thereafter


Pole Vault:
